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Construction Stormwater Management



Overview

Local, State and Federal regulations require the owner of a construction site that disrupt or expose soil, or remove vegetation from one or more acres to obtain local and State Stormwater Construction Permits. Failure to do so can result in tens of thousands of dollars in fines and/or imprisonment.

Since the implementation of the Clean Water Act, our organization has developed a Stormwater Management System that assist land owners, contractors, architects and engineers develop a comprehensive Stormwater Management Plan.

We have prepared almost 100 Stormwater Management Plans for a wide variety of residential, commercial and industrial activities throughout Western Colorado.

Stormwater Management System

Because of the wealth of experience gained during the preparation of past Stormwater Management Plans, a unique system has been developed in preparing a plan that in most cases can be delivered within one week, for a fixed fee.

The plan is prepared in a narrative style that meets, or exceeds, local and State requirements. In addition to completing the various governmental application forms, the plan is presented in six parts:

1. Description of Planned Activities
2. Site Plan Map and Best Management Plan (BMP) Detail Drawings
3. Control BMP's
4. Final Stabilization Practices
5. Cost Estimates
6. Inspection & Maintenance Forms



Each plan is prepared in a manner to achieve the following three goals:

GOAL 1: Control all stormwater discharges in an effective and efficient manner.

GOAL 2: Utilize materials and products for control features that are readily available locally, or on-site.

GOAL 3: Establish control features that require the least amount of expense to maintain throughout the length of the activity.

An Alternative Approach

Inherent within the exclusive Stormwater Management System, is the ability to customize the services offered to meet the specific stormwater needs established by the owner. In other words, just basic plan preparation can be provided, together with, or any other part of the full range of services offered from the plan implementation, to inspections and final stabilization permit releases.
